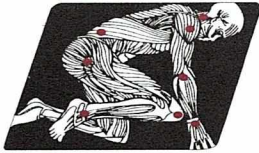

We are closed 6 holidays a year and close early the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and on New Year's Eve because family time is important!
